Eligibility

Books by Mail is only for individuals who are unable to leave home because of a temporary or permanent disability.

Delivery

Once you are registered for the Books by Mail service, materials are sent in a reusable envelope by book rate through the United States Postal Service. The packages are delivered to your home and **must be** returned in the same envelope by depositing them in a mail box or by having the letter carrier pick them up. The address card in the front envelope must be reversed so that our address and the pre-paid return postage are showing.

Up to four Books by Mail deliveries per month per customer will be made. (Each mailer bag holds approximately 3-4 books.)
